2. Drakenstein Municipality acts on illegal road activities

Drakenstein Municipality is determined to ensure the safety of everyone on the roads within the Drakenstein area. Therefore the municipality's Law Enforcement embarks on regular Law Enforcement actions against illegal road activities.

The Municipality's Law Enforcement in cooperation with SAPS and Western Cape Traffic Department had successful operations in the Drakenstein area on Saturday night, 9 March 2014. These operations in Klein Drakenstein Way (Stoepe and BP Garage), Jan van Riebeeck Road (Parys Road), Lady Grey Street, Paarl Main Road and Cecilia Street (near Paarl Mall) is one of the ways that the municipality is using to curb the illegal activities on the roads.

Perpetrators were issued with fines ranging from driving without licenses, no vehicle licenses, disregarding red traffic lights, failure to wear seatbelts; defects in vehicles, and parking inconsistent with road traffic signs, on pavements, on red lines and in front of private entrances. Various traffic fines to the total value of R19 300 were issued. Three arrests for driving under the influence of alcohol were also made. The use of a vehicle was also suspended because it did not comply with the legal road standards.

The Drakenstein Municipality requests the public to obey the rules of the road at all times. The municipality will continue with Law Enforcement actions in order to change the behavior of road users and to ensure the safety of everyone on the roads of Drakenstein area.
